

AED Battery and Defibrillator Pad Replacement Procedure

Prior to contacting RPS for a an AED Battery or Defib Pads, fill out the order form and email it to chrisk@rpsems.com

If you are replacing Defib Pads after using them on a call, submit the order form along with the 911 CAD number and a copy of the run sheet or PCR.

If you are replacing Defib Pads because they have expired, return the expired set along with your order form. These can be dropped off at RPS Moody located at 2230 Moody Pkwy Moody, AL 35004.

If you are replacing a faulty AED Battery, return the battery along with your order form. These can also be dropped off at RPS Moody.

You must be enrolled in the replacement program in order to participate in this program, If you are not already on the list of participating departments, you will have to wait until the open enrollment period to sign up.

During the open enrollment period (which is set by the COG), they have to submit an inventory of their AED & Cardiac Monitor serial numbers, makes and models.

In order to be eligible, the department must have already submitted to RPS a complete inventory of AED and/or Cardiac Monitors and must also be a current member, in good standing, of the St. Clair County Fire and EMS Association as well as a current COG member in good standing!
